ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE:

Check-in will be every morning from 8:15 - 8:45 AM at the designated drop off location marked by signs. During your first day camp check-in of the summer, our health care volunteer or designated staff person will review your health form and check-in any medications (in original container/packaging please). Also we will collect all the remaining payment and camp store money.

For additional weeks all you have to do is update any information is needed and we will collect remaining payment balances and store money.

Pick-up time will be 4:45 - 5:20. Please bring your photo ID to pick up. On your child's last day of camp, you will be able to collect all unused store money.

PAYMENT

Payment must be received in full BEFOREyour camper may be admitted to camp. If your church or someone else is assisting with payment, please ensure that it is taken care of in advance or be prepared to pay your balance and get reimbursed.

SUPERVISED ACTIVITIES:

Archery, swimming, waterfront activities, nature walks, arts and crafts, campfire, field games, camp games, gaga ball.

WHAT TO BRING:
